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The purpose of this writing is to serve as an annual review and summary of the data specific to PREA related incidents and events for calendar year 2019 at the Glades County Sheriff's Office. This information will also be forwarded to ICE for review, as required by policy.

The facility reports eight PREA related reviewed events during the past year. Of these, five were found to be unsubstantiated, and three were found to be Unfounded. A brief summary of the incidents is as follows:

The first was a reported allegation of sexual misconduct of a male officer by a male detainee. The detainee reported that he was improperly touched by a male officer. The allegation was reported to staff. An investigation into the allegations found no evidence to support any of the reported events and the incident was found to be unfounded.

The second involved a report by a male detainee of sexual harassment by another male detainee. The alleged incident was reported to staff. The reported information and statements were obtained and reported, the incident were found to be unfounded.

The third incident was a reported incident of sexual harassment reported by a female detainee against another female detainee. The event were reported to staff, the complaint was determined to be unsubstantiated.

The fourth incident involved a female detainee reporting she had been sexually harassed by another female detainee. The allegation was reported to a staff member. There was no evidence to support the allegation and it was found to be unsubstantiated.

The fifth incident involved a report of sexual harassment by female detainee by another female detainee. The allegations were reported to staff, the reported information and statements were obtained. The incident were found to be unsubstantiated


The sixth incident involved an allegation of sexual misconduct of a male inmate by another male inmate. The events were reported verbally to staff. The investigation was completed, and no evidence was obtained to support the allegation. The allegation was found to be unsubstantiated.

The seventh incident involved an allegation of sexual harassment of a male inmate by another male inmate. The allegation was reported via the facility PREA Hotline. An investigation into the allegation found no evidence to support the allegation and it was found to be unfounded.

The eighth incident involved a report of a sexual assault by an unknown medical staff member against a male detainee. The alleged allegation was reported to ICE staff at the Miami Field Office. The incident was documented and a investigation into the allegation was completed and no evidence to support the allegation. It was found to be unsubstantiated.

In these documented cases, PREA protocols, notifications and investigative responses were implemented. Currently, no further PREA related preventative protocols have been identified for future implementation.
