The purpose of this writing is to serve as an annual review and summary of the data specific to PREA related incidents and events for calendar year 2020 at the Glades County Sheriff's Office. This information will also be forwarded to ICE for review, as required by policy.

The facility reports seven PREA related reviewed events during the past year. Of these, six were found to be unsubstantiated, and one was turned over to ICE Miami Field Office for further investigation. A brief summary of the incidents is as follows:

The first involved a report by a female detainee of sexual harassment by another female detainee. The alleged incident was reported to staff. The reported information and statements were obtained and reported, the incident was found to be unsubstantiated.

The second incident was a reported incident of sexual misconduct reported by a male detainee against another male detainee. The event was reported to staff, the complaint was determined to be unsubstantiated.

The third incident was reported by a male inmate of sexual assault and sexual comments by an unknown Officer while being placed on the ground. The allegation was reported to a staff member. There was no evidence to support the allegation and it was found to be unsubstantiated.

The fourth incident involved a report of sexual misconduct by a female detainee by another female detainee. The allegations were reported to staff, the reported information and statements were obtained. The incident was found to be unsubstantiated.


The fifth incident involved an allegation of sexual assault of a male inmate by another male inmate. The events were reported verbally to staff. The investigation was completed, and no evidence was obtained to support the allegation. The allegation was found to be unsubstantiated.

The sixth incident involved an allegation of sexual harassment of a male inmate by another male inmate. The allegation was reported via telephone to DRIL line with ICE. An investigation into the allegation found no evidence to support the allegation and it was found to be unsubstantiated.

The seventh incident involved a report of a sexual assault by medical staff at a hospital in Miami prior to the detainee being housed at our facility. The alleged allegation was reported through ICE DRIL line. The incident was documented and was investigated into the allegation; the report was forwarded to the ICE SDDO for their investigation.

In these documented cases, PREA protocols, notifications and investigative responses were implemented. Currently, no further PREA related preventative protocols have been identified for future implementation.
